As a member of Wicklow Archers Archery Club, you are expected to abide by the following code of practice:

## ALL MEMBERS ARE EXPECTED TO:

- · Be friendly and particularly welcoming to new members.
- · Keep within the defined boundaries of the shooting / waiting area.
- · Behave and listen to all instructions from the coach.
- · Play within the rules and respect club officials and their decisions.
- · Take care of equipment owned by the club or other members.
- · Refrain from the use of bad language or racial/sectarian references.
- · Refrain from bullying or persistent use of rough and dangerous play.
- · Keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or club official
- · if they are going to be late or leave early.
- · Wear suitable kit for training and archery sessions, as outlined by the club.
- · Pay any fees for training or events promptly.
- · Keep themselves and others safe.
- · Report inappropriate behaviour or risky situations.
- · Play fairly and be trustworthy.
- · Show appropriate loyalty and be gracious in victory or defeat.
- · Respect opponents.
- · Make your club a fun place to be.

## ALL MEMBERS HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- Be listened to.
- · Be respected and treated fairly.
- · Enjoy your sport in a protective environment.
- · Be protected from abuse by other member or outside sources.
- · Participate on an equal basis, appropriate to their ability.
- · Ask for help.
